Figure 1: ELF@Home website visits per month I

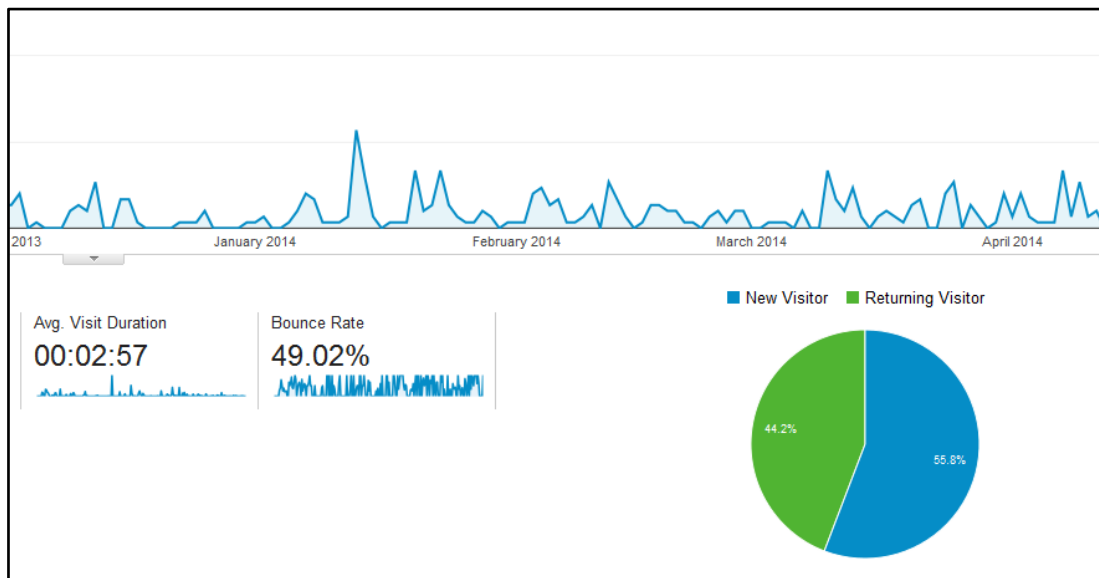


Figure 2: ELF@Home website visits per month II

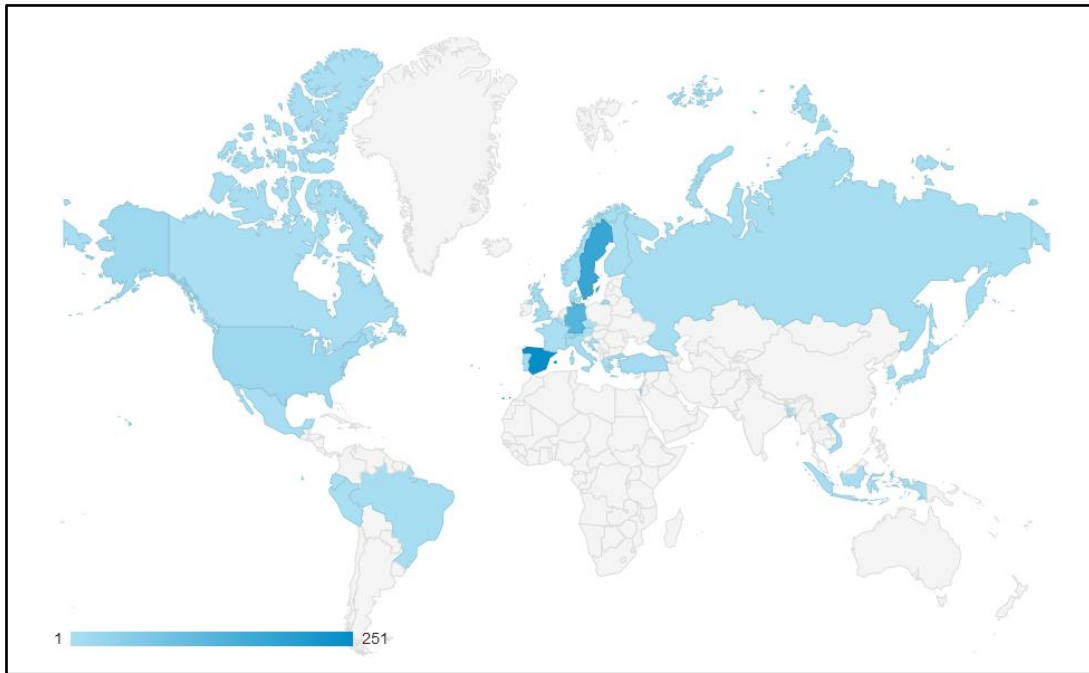


Figure 3: ELF@Home website visits per country I
